Key Vocabulary and definitions The edge, or boundary, perimeter of an area or shape. 2D **shapes** with closed regular sides, where all sides are shape the same length and all the interior angles are equal. 2D shapes with closed irregular sides, where the sides and angles are not equal. The amount of space inside a shape. A 2D shape with straight rectilinear sides and right angles.
