

2023 Headlines for KS2:

- Two thirds of children in KS2 own a games console
- Most children in KS2 watch content on Youtube
- Three quarters of children have not received an unkind message or image online
- · Half of children know what PEGI ratings are
- One third of children admitted playing games with a higher PEGI rating than their age
- One third of children spend up to 2 hours online each day excluding school (10% more than 4 hours)
- Two thirds of children have screentime limits during the week
- Slightly less than half have screentime limits during the weekend
- One quarter of children feel pressured to look perfect online
- 12% feel that spending too much time online is a problem for children and young people
