2021/22 Impact on pupils' attainment and progress

Following the pandemic we have continued to monitor progess and attainment for disadvantaged pupils, compared with their respective peers through termly teacher assessments in reading, gaps and maths. We have also monitored writing half termly using teacher assessments. The school has also completed termly assessments in reading and maths (gaps in KS2) as well as 'No more marking' writing assessments in all year groups across the school.

We have found that whilst PP children in the main attain at a lower rate than their peers, they are making good or better progress. This is due, in part, to additional tuition completed outside of the school day. Each session is carefully overseen by class teachers and monitored by SLT ibn school. Areas of need are identified and year group staff support pupils in small group work. The adults are either their class teacher or another adult from their year group. This model works well because there is already a positive relationship to begin with and the adults know how best to support the children. Families are also 'kept in the loop' and can offer further support at home.
