Our approach to learning at home – January 2021

For the remainder of the current lockdown, we will be moving all our learning online. For the majority of pupils, home learning tasks will be set on **MS Teams** by school staff. Foundation stage pupils will continue to use **Tapestry**. Keyworker and vulnerable pupils that are attending school will continue to learn in the classroom. Their lessons will reflect the online learning and we do not expect these children to complete further learning at home. We will set at least 3 hours of online learning per day (not 3 hours of live teaching but a combination of live, recorded and associated tasks or external links).

Meet your teacher online **Live**.

Continue to read at home and complete other ongoing tasks (e.g. spelling or tables practice).

Follow recorded or live content during the week.

Send your work in for feedback via Teams.



Topic work will be set and include other subjects.

Teachers will provide feedback on tasks.

EVERY child will be set work to move learning on. Teachers will work together to support learning for pupils with SEND.

Ask for help from Teachers between 8:30 – 3:30 (they will reply when they can).
