We are learning about:

We have started to learn about the season of summer. We have been identifying signs of summer and how to look ourselves when it is warm.

We will be learning about the seaside for the remainder of the term and taking part in beach themed activities.

We are hoping to make our own paddling pool area.

Mrs Patel has been working hard with the children to plant flowers, fruits and vegetables in our garden. We will be sampling these before the end of term. So far, we have... potatoes, mint, lettuce, rhubarb and strawberries.
